- Labor Costs in South Korea -

Labor costs are an important factor in establishing and operating a business in Korea. Wages in Korean companies often vary depending on several factors that usually remain vague to foreigners. We collected some hard data regarding the labor costs in Korea.

Tables and data presented in this overview focus on the salary level in Korea and tackle both the private and the public sector, which may give readers an interesting perspective about the general labor market situation.

This report contains the updated information for 2024, which has been acquired while conducting research at local institutions, ministries, and other Korean sources such as job portals.

The salary is fixed accordingly at 1,012,500 KRW for a freshman of the first year, at 1,125,000 KRW for the second year, at 1,250,000 KRW for the third year and at 1,375,000 KRW for the graduate year.

The salaries for police officers (cadet level) and fire fighters (cadet level) will be fixed at almost 80% of the salary equivalent to class 1 in the rank which is expected to be applied.

Staff who are paid according to Article 13 paragraph 2 of an "Enforcement Decree of Educational Officials Appointment" shall be appointed as teachers on a part-time basis.
